As per our communication plan, the District will provide periodic updates related to COVID-19 quarantines and isolations. Prior to the start of school we were notified by the health department that we had 6 students who were isolated and 43 in quarantine. Also, prior to the start of school, we had 2 isolated employees and 3 in quarantine.

As of today we have <u>12</u> student isolations and <u>84</u> student quarantines. Additionally, we have <u>5</u> isolated employees and <u>8</u> quarantined employees.

These are not concentrated on any particular campus and the vast majority of the current positive cases appear to be the result of community or household spread.

This highlights the importance of not only managing hygiene and social distancing at school but also while we are away from school. While our cases have risen to some degree we are still comparing very well to our neighboring districts due in large part to the strict handling of protocols and consistency among our students and staff throughout the school day. I applaud everyone's efforts to keep us safe, learning, and in school.
