Eagle Nation,

I am writing to provide you with an update of our District's numbers related to COVID-19 quarantines and isolations.

I am encouraged to report that our numbers continue to steadily improve.

As of this Friday afternoon, October 8th at 2:30 p.m., our known data shows our active Joplin City cases are at 48 with a combined area hospital occupancy of 17. Across the District, we are showing a total of 10 active cases. Seven of these are students and three are staff members.

On the quarantine front, Joplin Schools now has eight staff and 27 students with quarantine designation.

This serves as a good reminder that a fully vaccinated status may not only help protect you from the serious effects of COVID-19 but also prevent a quarantined status.

As always, masking and other mitigation strategies are encouraged.
