Eagle Nation,

I am writing to provide you with an update of our District's numbers related to COVID-19 quarantines and isolations.

I am encouraged to report that our numbers continue to stay relatively low.

As of this Friday afternoon, October 22nd at 2:30 p.m., our known data shows our active Joplin City cases are at 56 with a combined area hospital occupancy of 22. Across the District, we are showing a total of 19 active cases. Sixteen of these are students and three are staff members.

On the quarantine front, Joplin Schools now has two staff and 36 students with quarantine designation.

This serves as a good reminder that a fully vaccinated status may not only help protect you from the serious effects of COVID-19 but also prevent a quarantined status.

As always, masking and other mitigation strategies are encouraged.
