Eagle Nation,

I am writing to provide an update of our District's numbers related to COVID-19 quarantines and isolations.

As of this Friday afternoon, September 10th at 2:30 p.m., our known data shows our active Joplin City cases are at 93 with a combined area hospital occupancy of 49. Across the District, we are showing a total of 24 active cases. Twenty-three of these are students and one is a staff member.

On the quarantine front, Joplin Schools now has 0 staff and 234 students with quarantine designation.

This serves as a good reminder that a fully vaccinated status may not only help protect you from the serious effects of COVID-19 but also prevent a quarantined status. This afternoon, we have 648 fully vaccinated staff and 69 substitutes in our vaccine incentive pool.

As always, masking and other mitigation strategies are encouraged.
